**ANNOUNCEMENT ON EU'S PROVISIONAL FINDINGS ON ANTI-DUMPING
PROCEEDING CONCERNING IMPORTS OF CERTAIN ALUMINIUM ROAD
WHEELS ORIGINATING IN THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA**

On 13 August 2009, the European Commission initiated an anti-dumping proceeding concerning imports of certain aluminium road wheels originating in the People's Republic of China. Accordingly, YHI International Ltd ("the Company") issued a relevant announcement on 20 August 2009 – "ANNOUNCEMENT ON ANTI-DUMPING PROCEEDING CONCERNING IMPORTS OF CERTAIN ALUMINIUM ROAD WHEELS ORIGINATING IN THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA".

On 11 May 2010, the European Union ("EU") imposed a provisional anti-dumping duty of 20.6% on imports of aluminium road wheels originating in the People's Republic of China. This provisional anti-dumping duty effected on 12 May 2010 and will apply for a period of six months. The definitive final duty is expected to be announced by 11 November 2010.

Since the European Union imposed one country-wide duty of 20.6% on all imports of aluminium road wheels from China, the Company's exports of aluminium road wheels from China are subject to this provisional anti-dumping duty of 20.6%. The Company's exports of aluminium road wheels from its production facilities in Taiwan and Malaysia are not affected. Other businesses of the Company are also not affected.

The Company is currently in discussion with its legal representatives on the appropriate actions to be taken to minimize the impact of the European Union's final decision. The Company is given 30 days to submit its written response by 12 June 2010. The appropriate appeal procedures will be followed and a final decision by the European Union is expected by 11 November 2010.

The Company will monitor the development closely and make appropriate disclosure on the situation accordingly.
